

## GOK request replacement of coupling fast-release valves

Potential defect in valves for LPG applications established

Marktbreit, 7<sup>th</sup> February 2017 – The GOK quality assurance department has established a leak in two types of coupling fast-release valves. For reasons of precaution, the manufacturer of regulators and fittings requests all users to replace the affected coupling fast-release valves. Fields of application of these valves are in LPG installations in industry, recreational vehicles such as caravans and motorhomes as well as in other private and commercial LPG installations.

The replacement campaign involves the following types of coupling fast-release valves:

Coupling fast-release valve type SKU 03415

Junction coupling fast-release valve type SKU 03420

Valves with production date starting from January 2016 until January 2017 (codes 01.2016 to 01.2017) are affected. There is only a small probability that damages occur because of a leak. We have not heard yet of any damages caused by leaking coupling fast-release valves.

In unfavourable circumstances, however, gas could leak uncontrollably out of the installation in ongoing operation. This could accumulate and might lead to gas deflagration. That is why the coupling fast-release valves must be replaced. The manufacturer of regulators and fittings supports the users in the replacement campaign and assures them of a user-friendly procedure. GOK employees give advice and recommendations for precautions and how to replace.
